

# Covid-19 Vaccine:

## Know the facts, then get the Vax.

### Have questions about the Covid-19 Vaccine?

We're here to help you make the best, most informed decision about getting vaccinated to protect your family, friends, and community from the coronavirus.

### Who can get vaccinated?

- All individuals over age 12
- Not just for those who may suffer severe health consequences from corona virus
- Trying to reach herd immunity- when enough people are vaccinated that the virus cannot easily spread in the community.

### How can I be sure it's safe?

- FDA monitors safety very closely
- May seem like it was approved quickly, but research has been going on for years
- Vaccines are performing better in the community than they did in the laboratory!

### What are the side effects?

- Severe side effects are extremely rare
- Some people experience no side effects!
- Most common side effects are flu-like symptoms: chills, slight fever, sore arm, tiredness
- Nurse/health care provider can talk through symptoms with you before the shot



**Remember- the vaccine is free and available to all individuals ages 12 and up!**
