Get connected to an in-demand career in as little as one to two years – or start a four-year degree.

Eligible students can continue on to a bachelor's degree through a total of 40+ four-year partner colleges and universities.

To participate, you must:

Meet Academic and Eligibility Requirements Eligible students:

- Are 24 years or older as of December 31, 2021, and live in the MATC district
- Have an estimated family contribution (EFC) of \$6,500 or less based on federal student aid application (if you are in default on one or more prior student loans, you must apply by the priority deadline)
- Have earned at least six college credits but have not earned an associate or bachelor's degree
- · Have last attended college in December 2019 or earlier

Complete these steps by the **December 3, 2021** deadline to hear back sooner; **January 7, 2022** is the final deadline for Spring 2022.

Apply to MATC at matc.edu/apply. The application fee is now waived for Spring 2022. You'll get your MATC student ID number when you're done!
Complete a Promise Interest Form at matc.edu/promise – and use your new student ID number
Apply for Financial Aid at fafsa.gov. Complete the 2021-22 FAFSA® to start in Spring 2022.
Provide Your Official High School and College Transcripts Mail to: MATC Admissions 700 West State Street Milwaukee, WI 53233
Or visit the Admissions Center at any MATC campus
Register for Classes Enroll in at least six college-level credits linked to a top 50 in-demand career (see matc.edu/promise for a list of programs).

How Do I Stay in the Program?

- Enroll in at least six credits each Fall and Spring semester
- Earn at least a 2.0 semester GPA and complete 67% of credits attempted in the semester
- Complete a FAFSA annually continue
- . to meet income requirements
