# To participate, you must:

## Meet Academic and Eligibility Requirements

### Eligible students:

- Are 24 years or older as of December 31, 2021, and live in the MATC district
- Have an estimated family contribution (EFC) of \$6,500 or less based on federal student aid application (if you are in default on one or more prior student loans, you must apply by the priority deadline)
- Have earned at least six college credits but have not earned an associate or bachelor's degree
- Have last attended college in December 2019 or earlier

Complete these steps by the **December 3, 2021** deadline to hear back sooner; **January 7, 2022** is the final deadline for Spring 2022.

- Apply to MATC** at [matc.edu/apply](http://matc.edu/apply). The application fee is now waived for Spring 2022. You'll get your MATC student ID number when you're done!
- Complete a Promise Interest Form** at [matc.edu/promise](http://matc.edu/promise) – and use your new student ID number
- Apply for Financial Aid** at [fafsa.gov](http://fafsa.gov). Complete the 2021-22 FAFSA® to start in Spring 2022.

- Register for Classes** Enroll in at least six college-level credits linked to a top 50 in-demand career (see [matc.edu/promise](http://matc.edu/promise) for a list of programs).

## How Do I Stay in the Program?

- Enroll in at least six credits each Fall and Spring semester
- Earn at least a 2.0 semester GPA and complete 67% of credits attempted in the semester
- Complete a FAFSA annually – continue to meet income requirements

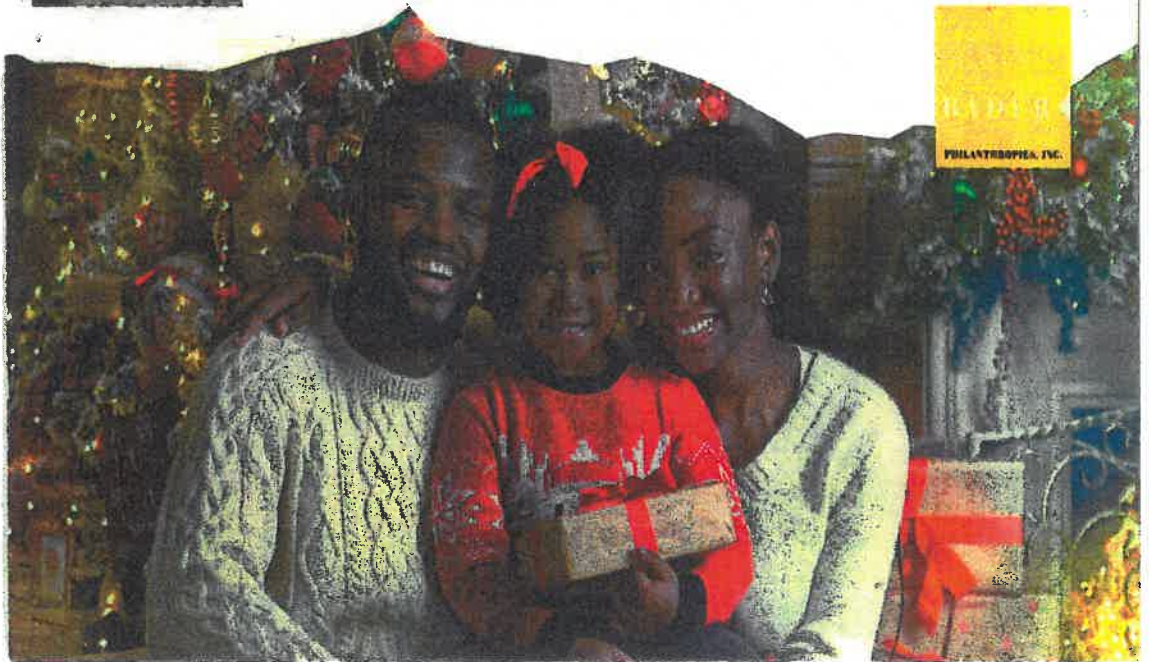
